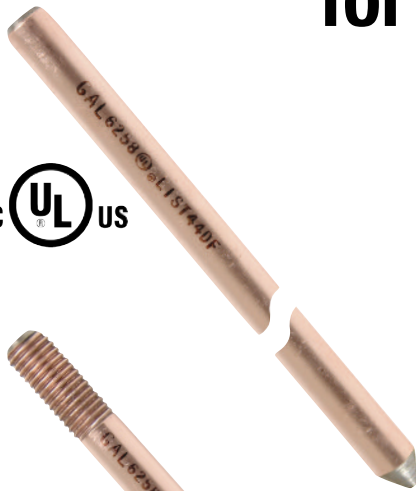

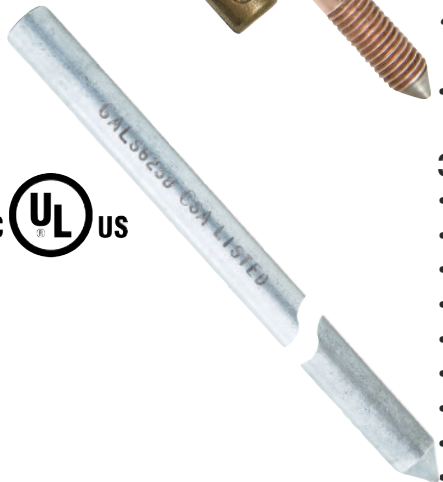

With Galvan copper-bonded pigtail ground rods, the grounding conductor is factory welded near the top of the rod, creating a permanent, corrosion-free bond. Galvan pigtail rods eliminate the safety hazards associated with exothermic welding in the field. They also reduce installation time.

Contact the factory for a quotation on copper-coated or hot-dip galvanized pigtail rods. Provide rod size, wire type, placement, gage and length. (Example: 5/8"x8' copper-coated rod with 12' of #6 bare solid copper pigtail to be attached 6" from the top or drive end of the rod.)
